**THERE ARE 2 PROPOSALS ON THE BALLOT.**

<b>CHARTER AMENDMENT FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT MILLAGE</b>	Shall Section 9.4 of the Charter of the City of Berkley, Oakland County, Michigan, be amended to permit the levy by the City of an additional ad valorem property tax in an amount not to exceed two (2) mills for ten (10) years, from 2019 through 2028, to acquire and construct capital improvements for the City, including roads, streets, water, sewer and other capital improvement projects? It is estimated that 2 mills would raise approximately \$1,142,783 when first levied in 2019.
<b>COMMUNITY CENTER BOND PROPOSAL</b>	Shall the City of Berkley, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Fifteen Million Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$15,375,000), payable in not to exceed twenty-one (21) years from the date of issue, and issue its unlimited tax general obligation bonds to pay the cost of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping a new community center, including demolition of existing structures, parking and site improvements? The estimated millage to be levied in 2019 is 0.8837 mills (\$0.88 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 1.6335 mills (\$1.63 per \$1,000 of taxable value).
