THERE ARE 2 VILLAGE PROPOSALS ON THE BALLOT.

CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSAL NO. 1	The Village Charter now states that each Councilperson and President shall be paid on a monthly basis seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per meeting of the Council actually attended by him or her, to a maximum of three hundred seventy-five dollars (\$375) per year. The proposed amendment would change such compensation to fifty dollars (\$50) per meeting of the Council attended by him or her, to a maximum of Fifteen Hundred dollars (\$1,500) per year. Shall the proposal be adopted?
CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSAL NO. 2	Should Section 8.5 of the Village of Milford Charter be amended to replace the current levy of 3.5 mills, as reduced by the required millage roll-backs, set to expire in 2022, and the current levy of 1 mill for the years 2023 through 2032, with a new levy of 2.9 mills (\$2.90 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), for a period of 14 years, 2019 through 2032, and subject to authorized disbursements mandated by law, for the purpose of defraying the cost of major and local road maintenance, estimated to provide revenue of \$708,792 in the year 2019? Shall the proposal be adopted?
