EPA awarded Oakland County \$600,000 grant to help local communities assess and clean brownfield sites for future economic development, the county partnered with several communities, Pontiac is one of those communities.</li> <li>3. Protect at risk groups---I will continue to support testing of drinking water in our schools and child care centers. Oakland County has allocated funds for water stations in the schools.</li> </ol>
