Speakers: Oakland County Commissioners Marcia Gershenson & William Dwyer

Topic: Curbing Gun Violence

Bill Dwyer, Chairman of the Public Services Committee, and Marcia Gershenson, minority chair of the Government Committee, have joined forces to educate Oakland voters on "Curbing Gun Violence". "Gun violence in this country has reached a fever pitch and we must address it," said Dwyer. "Today it is the number one concern of all Americans. Looking at this issue and the relationship between mental health and gun violence, funding for mental health must be part of the conversation as we seek solutions on how to address gun violence."



Marcia Gershenson, (D) Oakland County Commissioner, District #13

Gershenson is a native Michigander, born and raised in Detroit. She attended the University of Michigan and graduated with a BA in English and a secondary teaching credential. She is married to Ken Robinson and has one son Drew and 3 step sons and families. She was a founder of Gilda's Club/Metro Detroit, a cancer support community. She serves on the board of several non-profit organizations. Some significant professional accomplishments include chairing the first Childhood Obesity Conference in Oakland County, creating the Women's Commission, and being a champion for Buy Local initiatives that support small business and local entrepreneurs. She represents parts of West Bloomfield Township, Bloomfield Township and Farmington Hills.



William Dwyer, (R) Oakland County Commissioner, District #14

Dwyer, a Michigan native, has been involved with law enforcement for over 48 years. He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy and obtained a master's degree in Criminal Justice from Wayne State University in 1983. Bill Dwyer was a long-time Police Chief in Farmington Hills, winning numerous awards. He was President of the MI Association of Chiefs of Police from 2001-2002. He also served as Police Commissioner in Warren. Elected Oakland County Commissioner in 2010, he is Chairman of the Public Services Committee. Commissioner Dwyer has been married to his wife Doris since the age of 19 and they have two adult sons. He represents Farmington, part of Farmington Hills, Southfield Township, Beverly Hills, Bingham Farms, and Franklin.


